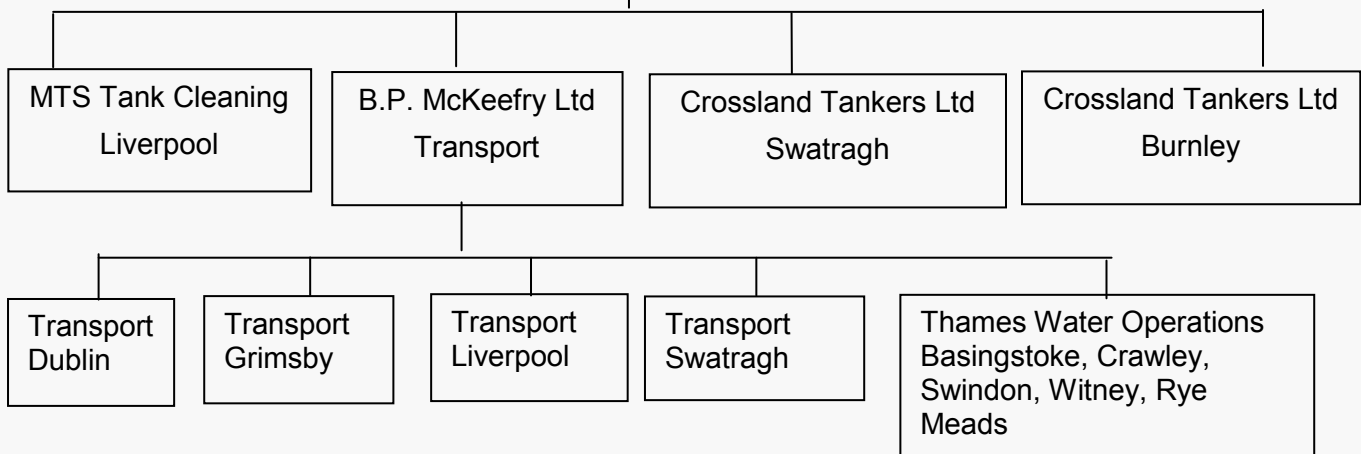
Maurice is based in Basingstoke and has been working on the sludge haulage contract since 1989. Some of the quotes from Maurice that have made people smile over the years are:
